






Looking to enjoy the spring weather? You've got plenty of options in and around Louisville. **Red River Gorge** is a popular spot for hiking, camping, picnicking, climbing and more! If you're a bit more daring, you can also book a zipline tour, which takes you across multiple ziplines 300 feet above the Gorge at speeds up to 55 mph.



Another great option is **Bernheim Arboretum and Research Forest**, which offers so much more than just hiking. You can stop in the Education Center to view the art gallery and to watch birds and small mammals interact in their natural habitat. Food grown in the Edible Garden is used in the on site café, so be sure to grab a snack! If heights don't scare you, you can climb up the 961 feet to the top of the fire tower for one of the best views in the state, and the Canopy Tree Walk extends into the forest canopy 75 feet above the forest floor.

Even if you've never been to Louisville, you know that it's the home of the Kentucky Derby. While the Derby itself is still a few weeks away, there are so many events leading up to it that are worth checking out. Not the least of which is Thunder Over Louisville, which is taking place on April 21st. This marks the 29th year for Thunder Over Louisville, which is the largest annual pyrotechnics display in North America. This year's theme is "A Disco Thunder," so you know what to expect from the musical score!

While the fireworks are the main event, there's also plenty to keep you busy while you're waiting for the big show. Choose from more than 115 food vendors and check out the Meijer Family Fun Zone, which includes bounce houses, face painting, photo opportunities and more! #### • Returning Champions

- **-Austin Vukovits**, Fishers, Indiana Vukovits returns to the tournament after shooting rounds of 72-72-70 for a tournament total of 1-over-par 214. The win was his first AJGA victory.
- **-Kelly Sim**, Edgewater, New Jersey Sim returns to the tournament after shooting rounds of 73-71-73 for a tournament total of 7-over-par 217. The win was her fifth AJGA victory.

#### • Notable players to watch

- -Rachel Kuehn, Asheville, North Carolina Kuehn is No. 24 in the Rolex AJGA Rankings. She is the highest-ranked player in the field. She has steadily climbed through the rankings since her first win at the AJGA Junior All-Star at Spring Valley in 2016. In 2017 she finished second at the Strategic Communications / Justin Thomas Junior Championship presented by Phocus and won the Billy Horschel Junior Championship presented by Zurich, CVS Health and Wyndham Rewards.
- -Noah Gillard, Greenwood, Indiana Gillard is the highest-ranked boy in the tournament at No. 37 in the Rolex AJGA Rankings. He is looking for his first AJGA win, but in 2017 he took home first at the Bubba Conlee National Junior and finished T7 at the Boys Junior PGA Championship. He also finished T6 in this event in 2017.


